JUMPERS

Open to all horse and rider combinations capable of showing Short Stirrup or above.

USEF Table 2.11.b.9 (jump off round class) If rider goes clean in the first round to this class without leaving the ring upon an audible signal, start the designated jump off course. Least number of faults in the fastest time wins. First round may also be timed; that will make it possible to break the ties of horses with four faults.

UESF Table 2.11.C (power and speed) Rider must jump first round clean and upon crossing the finish line of the power part continues immediately to the jump off course, the speed part. Time starts as the rider crosses the finish line of the initial course.
